


# STATE HOMES UPDATE

We're excited to announce that many new state homes in Roskill South are finished or nearly finished. In Stage 1, a total of 126 state homes have been completed with a remaining 23 homes set to be finished by the end of 2021. Stage 2 has seen all new housing lots complete with an additional 60 state homes finished and tenanted. Stage 3 is also well underway with 87 state homes to be included in this stage. In Stage 4, customers of old state homes have been relocated and the old houses removed. Civil works partner Piritahi has started on land remediation with civil works commencing in August 2021.

## CHARACTER STREETSCAPING

Civil works partner Piritahi is making great progress preparing land and infrastructure to build many more new warm, dry homes in Roskill South. With infrastructure and utility upgrades well underway and nearing completion in many parts of the neighbourhood, 'streetscaping' is the next step before the roads are re-opened.

Streetscaping improves safety, accessibility, connectivity and the overall appearance of the neighbourhood. As part of this work, you'll see Piritahi's teams on Kallu Crescent, Roseman Ave and Freeland Ave boxing and pouring concrete for new footpaths, installing kerbing and laying and rolling new road surfaces.

## WHAT DOES STREETSCAPING DO?



Wider footpaths, pedestrian crossings and upgraded street lighting improve pedestrian safety and accessibility.



New roading, pedestrian crossings and traffic calming measures, like raised speed tables, will help manage the speed of vehicles in the neighbourhood and make streets safer for pedestrians and cyclists.



Planting native trees and rain gardens will improve our neighborhoods' visual amenity, while also helping to manage the flow of stormwater.



Piritahi is our civil works alliance. They prepare the land, remove old state homes and upgrade streets and infrastructure before building starts.

# ROSKILL SOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRESS UPDATE


Construction of 186 Stage 1 and 2 state homes is complete and customers are now settled in the new warm, dry homes. The remaining 23 Stage 1 state homes are expected to be complete later this year. There are also 124 market and affordable homes currently under construction with an additional 150 new homes commencing in 2021.

Stage 3 development is also underway. The first round of state homes from this stage were completed in July, with an additional 60 under construction and 27 more due to commence.

Construction on market and affordable homes is set to start later in 2021. Stage 4 house removals are now complete and civil works are well underway.

\*Approximate numbers only. Around 50% of the market homes will be in a more affordable price range (i.e. priced from \$500,000 to \$650,000 delivered under the KiwiBuild programme). The total number of new homes delivered to the Roskill South neighbourhood is around 1000 homes.



## **ESTIMATED DEVELOPMENT TIMELINE**

#### Autumn 2021

- Stage 1 and 2 state houses complete
- Stage 3 state house construction commences
- Stage 4 house removals commences

#### Winter 2021

- First complete Stage 3 state homes
- Stage 4 civil works commences
- More market and affordable homes to start construction and available to purchase off the plans

## Spring 2021

- First market and affordable homes complete
- Stage 4 state house construction commences
- Stage 3 market and affordable homes construction commences

## **Summer 2021 / 22**

- More Stage 2 market and affordable homes complete
- Freeland Reserve upgrade complete
